Applications are invited for the post of Basic Grade Psychologist on permanent full-time basis. The successful applicant will provide psychological services to adults, including adults with dementia.

The successful candidate must have:

- Postgraduate qualification in Clinical, Counselling or Educational Psychology recognised by the Psychological Society of Ireland (qualifications obtained outside of the Republic of Ireland must be validated by the Department of Health and Children and proof of validation must be submitted with application).
- Applicants with a counselling or educational psychology qualification must demonstrate that they have acquired in appropriate health setting, for the areas for which they wish to apply – Disability (Child and Adult) at least 60 days or equivalent supervised clinical placements as part of the professional qualification or at least 60 days or equivalent post qualification supervised work experience as a psychologist.
- Relevant experience working with people who have intellectual disabilities.
- Experience in Positive Behaviour Support.
- Experience in the design, implementation and monitoring of behavioural and therapeutic interventions.
- Experience in formal psychometric assessments, including dementia.
- Experience of working effectively within a team.
- Excellent interpersonal and organisational skills.
- Applicants must possess a full clean driving licence and access to a car.
